Died 11/6/1926 East Malvern, Victoria, Australia

Emigrated to Victoria on the *Aloe* with her sister arrived in Melbourne 6/11/1858

Married 20/9/1859 at St. Stephen's Church Richmond, Victoria, Australia **John Skinner Box** (contractor, architect 1829 -1912 [emigrated to Victoria on the *Anglesey* arrived in Melbourne 1852](#))

ii Sidney Horace John 21/3/1862 Collingwood baptised 20/6/1862 St Peter's East Melbourne (carpenter, married 18/5/1886 at St Matthew's Prahran, Clara Wrigley, stationer's assistant) died 7/3/1909 Austin Hospital Heidelberg Victoria buried 9/3/1909 Melbourne Cemetery. 3 children.

iii Amy Florence Jane 1864 Collingwood (dressmaker, married 15/2/1893 at St Matthew's Prahran, Alfred William Fletcher House, farmer) died 24/1915 at the Homeopathic Hospital, South Melbourne, Victoria buried 25/9/1915 Brighton Cemetery, Victoria. 2 children.

iv Edwin William Alexander 29/8/1865 East Melbourne Victoria died 24/11/1868 Fitzroy, Victoria buried 25/11/1868 Melbourne Cemetery.

v Rosina Bertha May 20/12/1866 East Melbourne (dressmaker, married 1. 17/11/1898 at Wesleyan Church, South Yarra, John Rainy Jouneau Creighton, storeman - 2 children; married 2. 28/10/1916 at East St Kilda, Charles Hall, contractor; 3. 21/11/1941 at Christ Church, Angus John Stratton, pensioner) died 7/7/1962 Alvena Private Hospital, Windsor Victoria cremated 9/7/1962 Springvale Crematorium.

(4) vi **Ernest George Henry** 23/2/1868 Richmond Victoria (painter decorator, married 28/12/1889 at Alexandra Street, South Yarra **Frances Annie Blunden** dressmaker) died 21/5/1913 Alfred Hospital Prahran, Victoria.
